

## Proceedings Instructions

The proceedings of the 16th International Workshop "Quantum Systems in Chemistry and Physics" (QSCP-XVI) will be published in the Springer bookseries *Progress in Theoretical Chemistry and Physics* [<http://www.springer.com/series/6464>]. The previous titles in the series can be found [here](#).

Each participant of QSCP-XVI is cordially invited to submit a contribution to the QSCP-XVI proceedings. **The official deadline for submitting contributions is January 31, 2012.** We expect the proceedings to appear before the Autumn of 2012.

Two types of contributions will be considered: (i) research papers related to the material presented at QSCP-XVI (typically between 10 and 20 pages in Springer's format); (ii) advanced review papers related to the material presented at QSCP-XVI (typically between 20 and 60 pages in Springer's format). All contributions will be peer-reviewed. The editors of the QSCP-XVI proceedings volume of *Progress in Theoretical Chemistry and Physics* will be:

Contributors should send an **electronic copy of the manuscript** along with a cover letter containing **names and e-mail addresses of at least three possible referees** to:

All submissions should be marked "QSCP-XVI Proceedings".

The electronic copy of the manuscript should consist of **ALL files used for the manuscript production** and will be sent in the form of a compressed archive (.zip, .tar, etc.) **along with the PDF file** of the complete manuscript. The cover letter may be sent as attachment (PDF file) or as plain text in the e-mail message. At a later stage, contributors will be requested to fill in a Consent to Publish (CTP) Form which will be provided in due time.

The Publisher will send a complimentary copy of the QSCP-XVI proceedings to the principal author of each contribution accepted for publication and of at least 10 pages. Further details will be given at a later date.
